



## Printing Hungarian from SAP® ECC 6.0

The SAP system will allow you to print Unicode international characters if your system supports them.

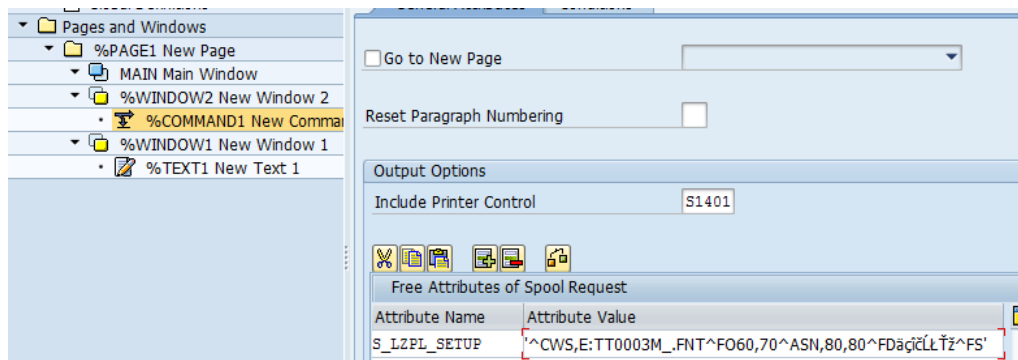
Printing international characters with the Swiss 721 font (TT003M\_.FNT) is dependent on the Device Type driver used, as YZB200U and LZEB2 will be slightly different.

This guides details the methods for both device types below:

### Device Type YZB200U

- Create a command node using the **S\_LZPL\_SETUP** attribute
- Use '**^CWS,E:TT0003M\_.FNT^FO60,70^ASN,80,80^FDäçîçĺłťž^FS**'
- Paste the characters from Word into the SAP screen (as below)

äçîçĺłťž



- Then ensuring the Printer Control of **S1401** (Latin-2 ISO 8859/2) is used

S1100	Activate character set ISO 8859/1 (Latin-1)
S1401	Activate character set ISO 8859/2 (Latin-2)
S1500	Activate character set ISO 8859/5 (Russian)

- Then printing the SmartForm should print the following label:  
(Using **YZB200U** dev type UK2)

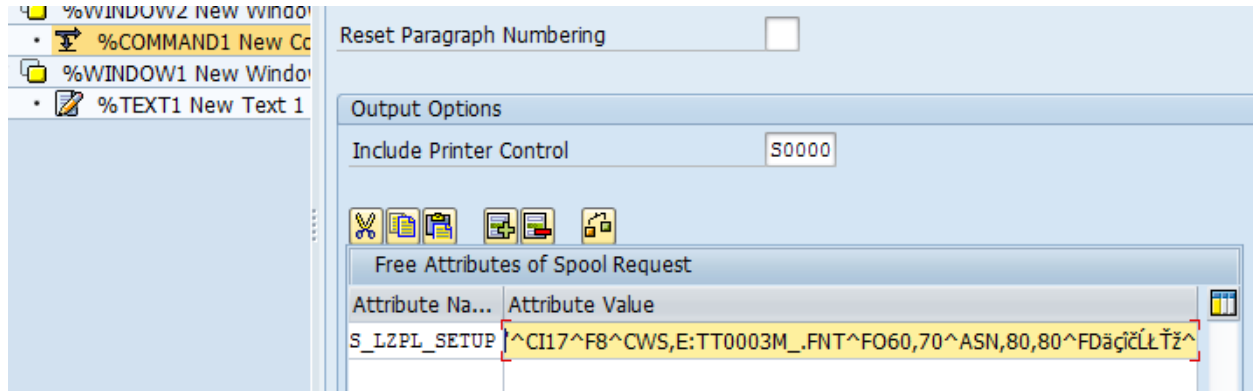

## Device Type LZBS2

- Create a command node using the **S\_LZPL\_SETUP** attribute
- Use '**^CI17^F8^CWS,E:TT0003M\_.FNT^FO60,70^ASN,80,80^FDäçîĉĽĹŤž^FS'**
- Paste the characters from Word into the SAP screen (as below)

äçîĉĽĹŤž



- Then ensuring the Printer Control of **S0000** (Standard character set) is used

S....	S.... Print controls for SAPscript
S0000	Activate standard character set
S1100	Activate character set ISO 8859/1 (Latin-1)

- Then printing the SmartForm should print the following label:  
(Using **LZBS2** dev type UK0)
